ADMISSION POLICY

Admission is given to all the candidates with preference for students from the locality (nearby

villages e.g.: Nuvem, Verna, Majorda, Raia, Betalbatim, Cansaulim, Benaulim, Rachol etc.)

[Neighborhood Criterion (NC)], irrespective of caste, religion, and financial status, provided

they meet with the rest of the criteria for admission stated by the Goa University.

Special preference is given to Economically Backward Candidates (EBC). No student is denied

admission on account of their inability to pay fees / costs of stationery / study material or even

the public transport fare (with student concession).

Implementation of Green Channel (GC): The students joining the College can secure their

admission to a higher degree program, as per the guidelines laid down by the university,

without any tension or worry.

Management Quota (15 seats) – Five seats each in Arts, Science and Commerce Streams

respectively is deemed as Management Quota (MQ) and admission to these vacancies is

granted solely at the discretion of the Management / Manager.

> Fee Concession is granted to the students depending on individual family financial condition.

Students can avail of Free-ships / Scholarships etc. under the Government schemes as well as

those offered by the Management on a case to case basis.

> Students who meet with NC (as above), especially the first-generation learners are given

priority (GC) admission even if they have a comparatively lower percentage than the other

aspiring students.
