

ADMISSION POLICY

- Admission is given to all the candidates with preference for students from the locality (nearby villages e.g.: Nuvem, Verna, Majorda, Raia, Betalbatim, Cansaulim, Benaulim, Rachol etc.) [**Neighborhood Criterion (NC)**], irrespective of caste, religion, and financial status, provided they meet with the rest of the criteria for admission stated by the Goa University.
- Special preference is given to Economically Backward Candidates (EBC). No student is denied admission on account of their inability to pay fees / costs of stationery / study material or even the public transport fare (with student concession).
- Implementation of **Green Channel (GC)**: The students joining the College can secure their admission to a higher degree program, as per the guidelines laid down by the university, without any tension or worry.
- Management Quota (15 seats) – Five seats each in Arts, Science and Commerce Streams respectively is deemed as **Management Quota (MQ)** and admission to these vacancies is granted solely at the discretion of the Management / Manager.
- Fee Concession is granted to the students depending on individual family financial condition. Students can avail of Free-ships / Scholarships etc. under the Government schemes as well as those offered by the Management on a case to case basis.
- Students who meet with NC (as above), especially the first-generation learners are given priority (GC) admission even if they have a comparatively lower percentage than the other aspiring students.
