

POLICY FOR PROMOTION OF RESEARCH

Carmel College of Arts, Science and Commerce for Women is affiliated to the Goa University and hence adheres to all the ordinances and regulations formulated by Goa University (Ordinance OA-19A under Section 24 (1) of the Goa University Act, 1984).

The College encourages research by-

- Providing research infrastructure facilities like Biodiversity Research Cell, Tissue Culture Laboratory, Zoology & Botany Major / Minor Research Laboratories, Psychology Laboratory, e-Commerce Laboratory etc. Spacious Laboratories equipped with advanced instruments, computer systems, Wi-fi connection, equipment, MIS and other facilities to carry on advanced research work are also made available.
- The college encourages faculty to apply for recognition as research guides for M.Sc. and M.A.
- The faculty pursuing research leading to a doctoral degree are encouraged to avail of the Faculty Development Program (FDP) offered by the UGC. Management provides administration and clerical support for all paperwork and procedural protocol. Leave once sanctioned by Government authorities is strictly adhered by the Management.
- The college encourages faculty to apply for Major and Minor research grants provided by Government organizations - Goa University Teachers Grant, UGC, DBT, DST, etc.
- If the syllabus that is drawn up by the University Boards of Studies has a component that has potential and / or opportunity for research, faculty and students are encouraged to take advantage of this and are fully supported by the college management and administration.
